

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2007-27**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE  
PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS AND PROVIDING FOR  
THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION.**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined according to state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property, and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities desire to sell such surplus property by public auction, and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION 1**

The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to surplus namely:

1. Miscellaneous found items registered with the Obenauf Auction Service, Inc.

**SECTION 2**

The said surplus items and equipment is to be sold at public auction and the Chief of Police is hereby directed to plan and supervise the delivery of the surplus items and equipment to the auction.

**SECTION 3**

The said surplus items and equipment listed in Section 1 shall not have any minimum bid.

**SECTION 4**

In the event that any word, phrase or portion of this ordinance shall be found invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5**

All ordinances or portions of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed but said extent only and except as so repealed; all other ordinances shall be and remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6**

The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

**SECTION 7**

This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number **2007-27**.
