AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FINAL APPROVALS FOR A PROPOSED BANQUET FACILITY AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS FOR PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS LOYOLA CUNEO MANSION AND MUSEUM LOCATED AT 1350 MILWAUKEE AVENUE, IN THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY

Published in pamphlet form by the Authority of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, this 6<sup>th</sup> Day of July 2010

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**WHEREAS**, Steve Bergfeld, representing Loyola University Chicago, in regard to property commonly known as Loyola University Cuneo Campus and legally described in Exhibit A, has petitioned the Village of Vernon Hills for approval of final site and landscaping plans and architectural elevations for the legally described property to be known as Loyola Cuneo Mansion and Museum, and;

**WHEREAS**, the final approvals would allow the rehabilitation and expansion of the Cuneo Mansion and Museum related to providing handicap accessibility to the museum with the addition of a new elevator and restrooms, renovation and conversion of the existing pool house into a commercial kitchen and restrooms and replacement of the existing tent with a permanent, 300-seat banquet room.

**WHEREAS**, after the public meeting held June 9, 2010 and continued from time to time by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the Village of Vernon Hills, and pursuant to the Vernon Hills Zoning Ordinance of 1982, as amended, said Planning and Zoning Commission has filed its report concerning said petition as listed above and recommended approval of final site and landscaping plans and building elevations for the rehabilitation and expansion of the Loyola Cuneo Mansion and Museum subject to certain conditions.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION I.** Pursuant to the Vernon Hills Zoning Ordinance of 1982, the final site and landscaping plans and architectural elevations for the entire project, as set forth in Exhibit B, are hereby approved subject to the conditions listed in Section II.

**SECTION II.** Pursuant to the Vernon Hills Zoning Ordinance of 1982, as amended, and the recommendations of the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Conditions of Approval, as set forth in Exhibit C, are hereby approved and are made a part of the approvals as listed in the Section above.

competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. **SECTION IV. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**SECTION V. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS.** All of the provisions of this Ordinance and the attachments hereto are binding on all successors and assigns of Loyola University Chicago.

**SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


**SECTION VII. ORDINANCE NUMBER.** This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2010- 039.

**Exhibit C**  
**Terms and Conditions of Approval**

- a) General compliance with the Pool House Renovation and New Pavilion plans as set forth in Exhibit B.
- b) Review and approval of landscaping plans by the Village Landscape Technician shall be required prior to issuance of a full building permit for the banquet facility project. The Landscape Technician may require plant substitutions where, in his opinion, the substitution is appropriate for this project.
- c) The petitioner shall provide cutsheets for the exterior lighting fixtures of the building and patio. Said fixtures shall be approved by the Village and be consistent with the testimony provided at the June 9, 2010 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting.
- d) The screening material for the rooftop HVAC units shall be of a similar type of material and color used for exterior walls.
- e) Compliance with all ordinances and standards of the Village except as may otherwise be provided.


