**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE PAYMENT TO
LANDMARK FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES.**

Whereas, Landmark Ford is an authorized Ford dealership and has been selected through a competitive bidding process to provide motor vehicles to municipalities in the State of Illinois at the rate specified in bid (contract), and the Ford Crown Victoria and Ford Expedition have been identified as the vehicle that best fits the purpose of the Vernon Hills Police Department for use in police/law enforcement operations.

Whereas, all purchases over \$10,000 require Board of Trustee approval, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

That the Village Manager is authorized to execute contracts to commit the Village to make payments to Landmark Ford not to exceed \$100,000 for the purchase of four Ford police vehicles.
