

RESOLUTION 2007-23

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2006-152 AND 2006-114 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO MAKE FINAL PAYMENTS FOR THE CDW WAY CROSSWALK

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board approved Resolution 2006-152 and 2006-114 allowing for the installation of a crosswalk on CDW Way to provide pedestrian access to the two CDW facilities; and

WHEREAS, CDW has agreed to reimburse the Village for the expenses of the installation in the crosswalk; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills were authorized and performed additional pavement resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, proposals were solicited for the concrete median, grinding and repaving of the roadway and pavement marking; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Road Rehabilitation contractor required remobilization and increased the unit prices due to the August 2006 labor and material increases to perform said work; and

WHEREAS, ALamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. final payment is \$77,330.60, which is \$5,247.60 above the Resolution 2006-152 limit and the Village's portion of the cost is \$39,960.84 which is \$7,960.84 above the Resolution 2006-152 limit; and

WHEREAS, CDW has been invoiced in the amount of \$46,489.70 for their portion of the work and these funds were unanticipated in the original budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

That the Village Board authorizes the Village Manager to make final payment to ALamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$77,330.60 and that the Capital Subfund Permanent Improvements account (0209109-550050) is hereby increased by \$37,100.00 based on unanticipated reimbursements from CDW and Public Works Commodities account (0102040-530990) is hereby increased by \$9,390.
