

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-101

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE NAMES OF ROADWAYS AT THE VERNON HILLS ATHLETIC COMPLEX WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS AND PROVIDING FOR NOTIFICATION OF SAME.

WHEREAS, roadways extending from Fairway Drive within the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex have been constructed to the stadium, playing fields, and facilities of the Village of Vernon Hills, School District #125, and School District #128; and

WHEREAS, Fairway Drive extends south from Continental Executive Parke through the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex and will extend to Route 45; and

WHEREAS, there are two Fairway Drive intersections within the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex; and

WHEREAS, at the north intersection, the roadway to the east shall be named “Cougar Way” and the roadway to the west shall be named “Memorial Drive”; and

WHEREAS, at the south intersection, the roadway to the east shall be named “Nike Parkway” and the roadway to the west shall be named “Patriot Way”; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance provides for the streets and their names.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Name of Roadway.

The designated roadways as noted in Exhibit A and within the Village of Vernon Hills shall be henceforth known as: at the north intersection, the roadway to the east shall be named “Cougar Way” and the roadway to the west shall be named “Memorial Drive”; and at the south intersection, the roadway to the east shall be named “Nike Parkway” and the roadway to the west shall be named “Patriot Way”.

SECTION 2. Notification.

The Village Clerk shall notify the election authority of the jurisdiction within the Village and the Post Office branch servicing the Village of such roadway name in writing by certified or registered mail.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

The naming of this designated roadway shall be effective thirty (30) days after the giving of the aforesaid notification by the Village Clerk as in Section 2 provided.

SECTION 4. Ordinance Number.

This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 2004-101.

SECTION 5. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed but except a so repealed, all ordinances shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Effective Date of Ordinance.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
