

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-83

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE VERNON HILLS EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ENHANCED 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FOR THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit, welfare, and best interests of the citizens of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, to establish an Emergency Telephone System Board for the implementation of the Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System; and

WHEREAS, certain amendments are necessary to comply with the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, that there be established a Vernon Hills Emergency Telephone System Board Advisory Committee appointed by the Village President with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION I. MEMBERSHIP OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO THE ENHANCED 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD. The Village President shall appoint the following as members of the Committee:

a) one Trustee to serve as Chairman of this Advisory Committee; b) the Chief of Police; c) one Deputy Chief of Police; d) one official of a Fire Protection District which District serves all or a portion of the Village; e) one citizen of the Village of Vernon Hills.

SECTION II. TERM OF OFFICE. Each member of the Advisory Committee to the Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System Board shall service for a four (4) year term commencing January 1, 2006.

SECTION III. DUTIES OF THE VERNON HILLS ENHANCED 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD. The Board shall have the responsibility of:

- (1) Planning a 9-1-1 system.
- (2) Coordinating and supervising the implementation, upgrading, or maintenance of the system, including the establishment of equipment specifications and coding systems.
- (3) Receiving monies from the surcharge imposed under Section 15.3, and from any other source, for deposit into a segregated Emergency Telephone System account within the General Fund.
- (4) Authorizing all disbursements from the fund.
- (5) All other duties and responsibilities as outlined by statute.

SECTION IV. DECISIONS. All decisions made by the Vernon Hills Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone system Board are not final, but are recommendatory to the Village Board.

SECTION V. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION VI. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION V. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2005-83.
