A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE HONORARY NAMES OF ROADWAYS AT THE VERNON HILLS ATHLETIC COMPLEX WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS

WHEREAS, the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex was used by the United States of America military for training during World War II; and

WHEREAS, during the 1950-60's Cold War the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex was the site of two Nike Missile Batteries; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Nike Missile Site is the designation to honor the previous use of the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex; and

WHEREAS, Fairway Drive and Cougar Trail are streets in the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, Fairway Drive, through the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex, honorary name is Veteran's Parkway and

THAT, Cougar Trail, in the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex, honorary name is "Aviator Way".
