

RESOLUTION 2006-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATIVE POLICING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Village of Indian Creek and the Village of Vernon Hills approved an Agreement for Cooperative Policing Services on January 11, 2000 and January 18, 2000 respectively, and

WHEREAS, the cost of Policing Services has increased since 2000, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the cost of services the Village of Vernon Hills has requested a financial contribution from the Village of Indian Creek to compensate a portion of police costs, and

WHEREAS, a formula could not be negotiated between the two Villages that was fair and equitable to the Village of Vernon Hills.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

That the Village Manager is directed to provide the six month termination notice to the Village of Indian Creek as outlined in Section 6 (a) of the INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATIVE POLICING SERVICES.

FURTHER, that the Village Manager and Police Chief are directed to meet with representatives of Indian Creek to clarify the operational implementation of this termination notice.
