

RESOLUTION 2006-173

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PETITION TO INSTALL A MULTIUSE CROSSING OF THE ELGIN, JOLIET, & EASTERN RAILROAD AT BUTTERFIELD ROAD AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT TO SIGN THE PETITION TO THE ILLINOIS COMMERCE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, there is an existing vehicular crossing of the Elgin, Joliet, and Eastern Railway (Crossing #26049F, Railroad Milepost 60.42) at Butterfield Road (Lake County Highway #57) in the Village of Vernon Hills; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills requests to install a pedestrian/bicycle path crossing adjacent to Butterfield Road linking two Village paths constructed on both sides and up to the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railway right of way.

WHEREAS, if approved and constructed, the Village will reimburse the Elgin, Joliet, and Eastern Railway for all costs incurred for the engineering and installation of the proposed pedestrian/bicycle path crossing.

WHEREAS, the Village agrees to post and maintain the Commission's standard "STOP – Look for Trains" signs at the edges of the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railway's right of way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

That the Village President is authorized to sign and the Village Clerk to attest the Illinois Commerce Commission Petition.
