2. KUMA’S CORNER, INVICTO AND LAZY DOG REQUEST A SPECIAL EVENT CLASS “E” LIQUOR LICENSE FOR MELLODY FARM SHOPPING CENTER, 849 MILWAUKEE AVENUE

Representatives of Melody Farm, on behalf of Kuma’s Corner, Invicto and Lazy Dog appeared before the Liquor and License Commission to request approval of a Class “E” liquor license authorizing the sale of beer and wine in connection with six special events. At its meeting of June 4, the Village Board approved a request from Melody Farm Shopping Center authorizing its 2019 schedule of outdoor special events (Resolution 2019-027). A condition of approval requires approval of a special event liquor license from the Liquor and License Commission for the six events that include the sale and service of beer and wine. These events include:

The sale and service of beer and wine would be from BASSET trained employees of the three restaurants holding the special event liquor license. Consumption would be limited to a roped off area on the central lawn. A copy of the applications and site plan for each event was attached to the packet.

Motion by Deputy Commissioner Schultz, second by Deputy Commissioner Marquardt, to approve a Class "E" liquor license to Kuma's Corner, Invicto and Lazy Dog for six special events at Melody Farm Shopping Center, 849 Milwaukee Avenue, as outlined above.




