Representatives of City Works Eatery & Pour House appeared before the Liquor & License Commission to request a Class A license. A Class A liquor license allows for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on premise.

Chief Kreis stated background checks have been submitted to the Illinois State Police. Petitioner is aware if the State liquor license is not approved, the Village has the right to rescind its liquor license.
