

RESOLUTION 2011-098

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VERNON HILLS PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH SUPERIOR PAVING, INC. TO PERFORM PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXISTING REAR STORAGE YARD AREA AT THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY LOCATED AT 490 GREENLEAF DRIVE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$22,000**

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees approved FY2011-12 budget which delineates \$16,000 in Public Works account 0102051-530090 to improve the Public Works Department rear storage area; and

WHEREAS, after a substantial cleanup of materials and strategic planning, it has been determined that the best use of the budgeted funds would be to pave the existing stone area of the rear storage yard due to continuous drainage issues; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department received proposals from three separate paving contractors, with Superior Paving, Inc. providing the lowest proposal of \$20,935; and

WHEREAS, the work to be completed within the contract includes the compacting and paving of the existing stone area of the Public Works storage yard; with Public Works staff performing the excavating of the current sloped area, the re-spreading of the existing stone; and re-grading with the cooperation of the Illinois Department of Transportation (I-DOT); and

WHEREAS, the additional costs beyond the delineated \$16,000 to have the work completed will be absorbed within the existing Public Works Department budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, the Village President is authorized to execute a contract with Superior Paving, Inc. for pavement improvements to the existing stone area of the rear storage yard at the Public Works Facility; and

THAT, the Village Manager is authorized to make payments to Superior Paving, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$22,000.




