

RESOLUTION 2011-106

A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE POLICE INVESTIGATION EQUIPMENT BUDGET BY \$5,300 FROM FUNDS CURRENTLY IN THE DRUG/ASSET FORFEITURE FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT TO BE USED IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS

WHEREAS, the Village has \$27,472 in funds from the sale, forfeiture and/or seizure of items, vehicles or cash obtained through the arrest or court proceedings involving dangerous/illegal drugs; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is authorized by legal statute to use this money (or other assets) in the continuing law enforcement efforts relating to criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is purchasing electronic surveillance equipment not budgeted for in the current budget year; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Resolution 2011-46 can be amended based on the existence of this revenue source to pay for the required equipment;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT the Police Investigation Equipment account (0103037-530040) is hereby amended to increase the budget in that account by \$5,300.


