

Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of May 13th:

Phase 2 of the Road Project will begin with the grinding of the existing asphalt surface this week in the Gregg's Landing Subdivisions of Cypress Pointe, Pebble Beach, Turtle Bay, Royal Birkdale, Broadmoor, Beaver Creek and Gregg's Parkway between Cypress Pointe and Huntington Drive, weather permitting. Some concrete work and cleanup will also occur this week.

Phase 2 of the project will include the grinding of the existing asphalt surface to a depth of 2-1/4" so that any asphalt patching, as necessary, can occur. Streets can be driven on and residents should be aware that at the curb and sidewalk crossings there will be drop please take caution when walking and driving.

After patching has occurred, the contractor will prepare the asphalt for final paving of a new surface course. Oil (Prime Coat) will be applied prior to the first lift of asphalt know as leveling binder. The asphalt leveling binder can be driven on shortly after its placed, minor delays can be expected. Please watch for the direction of the contractor and flagger persons.

Shortly after the leveling binder course has been placed the final surface lift will be placed. A light Oil application may be applied before the new asphalt surface is placed. Delays can be expected in this final step to allow for the compaction and cooling of the asphalt material. Please watch for the direction of the contractor and flagger persons.

All residents and guests are asked to not park on the street during the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm to allow for **Phase 2** operations to occur. Overnight parking on the streets is **not allowed** per Village Ordinance.

CAUTION: Asphalt paving is hot, protect yourself, children and pets when crossing or stepping onto the newly paved streets. Asphalt cools down within a few hours or longer when air temperatures are higher.

Avoid sharp turns, sudden stops and do not turn your wheels while standing still on the new asphalt. Proceed slowly and please watch for the direction of the contractor and flagger persons.
