

2024 Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of May 27th:

Residents are asked not to park vehicles on any of the streets during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm (Village working hours).

Paving on Gregg's Parkway will occur on a Saturday morning at an earlier time to reduce traffic delays.

Expect delays for all paving operations.

The contractor will be applying the prime coat (oil) with a light sand aggregate placed on top. The Contractor will apply a light coat to your driveway apron to reduce the risk of tracking it on to your driveway. The sand will be cleaned by the contractor once paving has been completed. Prime coat and sand application cures/dries in a short period of time and drivers should drive slowly to reduce the tracking onto your vehicles and driveways. A store bought bug/tar cleaner can remove any prime coat tracked onto your vehicles.

When the prime coat/oil is placed please be cautious of crossing the streets, especially with children and pets.

The first lift of asphalt being placed is the leveling binder and once the compaction by the rollers is completed the surface can be driven on. This usually takes about 5-10 minutes, please follow the direction of the contractor's workers and flag persons. Once all of the level binder course has been placed the contractor will proceed with the placement of the final asphalt surface lift.

A light coat of prime (oil) may be placed before the surface course placement, please watch for signs. Motorist should avoid making any sharp turns, turning their wheels from a complete stop, and sudden stops/starts with their vehicles on the new surface course until it cools enough.

**** When the asphalt surface courses are placed the asphalt is very hot and if the air temperatures are high, it takes longer for the pavement to cool down. Please remember to watch your children and pets when crossing into the streets.***
