

2024 Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of June 10th:

Residents are asked not to park vehicles on any of the streets during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm (Village working hours).

Final surface placement is scheduled to begin this week and will start in the subdivisions off Gregg's Parkway before paving Gregg's Parkway. All paving operations are subject to weather and may be delayed by rain.

Expect delays for all paving operations.

While the final surface is being placed motorists should avoid making any sharp turns, turning their wheels from a complete stop on the new asphalt, and any sudden stops/starts with their vehicles on the new surface course until it cools enough. Usually by the next morning.

**** When the asphalt surface course is being placed the asphalt material is very hot and if the air temperatures are high, it takes longer for the pavement to cool down. Please remember to watch your children and pets when walking on the new pavement.***

Final restoration of the disturbed areas from the concrete work will begin shortly after the final surface has been completed.
