

Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of June 16th:

Weather permitting the restoration work will begin this week

Punchlist work, including any irrigation repairs will also begin.

Pavement markings for the Road Rehabilitation Project will be installed tentatively the week of June 16th as well.

On Tuesday June 17th the entrance into the Centennial Crossing subdivision off Rt45 will be closed at 9:00am to complete the concrete work in this location. Residents and visitors will need to use Huron Street and Fairway Drive entrance and Barn Swallow/Ranney Avenue in the Stone Fence subdivision. The outbound Ranney Avenue to Rt45 will remain open during this time.

Work will be completed and the entrance re-opened on Friday June 20th.
