

RESOLUTION 2010-048

A RESOLUTION APPROVING LANDSCAPE CONCEPTS MANAGEMENT, INC. CONTRACT TO PROVIDE LANDSCAPING AND IRRIGATION MAINTENANCE FOR THE VERNON HILLS ATHLETIC COMPLEX AND AUTHORIZE A PURCHASE ORDER NOT TO EXCEED \$140,000

WHEREAS, \$140,000 is budgeted FY2010/2011 in Account 0115110-520600 for the landscape and irrigation maintenance of the Vernon Hills Athletic Complex; and

WHEREAS, Landscape Concepts Management, Inc. will not be performing infield maintenance in 2010, the Vernon Hills Cougar Youth Baseball Association will do the maintenance of all 6 fields, saving the Village \$45,910; and

WHEREAS, Landscape Concepts Management, Inc. will provide landscaping maintenance for the VHAC site for \$96,600; and

WHEREAS, Landscape Concepts Management, Inc. will maintain and make necessary repairs to original irrigation system that includes the pinwheel baseball fields, #1 - 4 and soccer/football fields #7 to 12 for \$8,200; and

WHEREAS, Landscape Concepts Management, Inc. will perform additional work for \$35,200 which includes: maintaining the areas adjacent to the Vortex parking lot; maintaining, servicing and repairing the newly installed irrigation system for Fields #5 and #6; power washing the asphalt paths, brick areas and the dugouts adjacent to the pinwheel fields, and providing needed repair, and maintenance of the soccer and football fields as well as the grass areas for the six baseball fields.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT a Purchase Order is issued to Landscape Concepts Management, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$140,000 and the Village Manager is authorized to make payments.




