

RESOLUTION 2016-011

**AUTHORIZING THE AMENDING OF THE DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF  
THE VERNON HILLS CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills requires Village Board approval for amendments to the Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, changes to Appendix B Development Regulations, Article I Development Ordinances, Appendix II Engineering Specifications are required in order for the Village to meet the Lake County Department of Public Works requirements and the current Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Construction in Illinois for Sanitary Sewer Systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the recommended amendments to the Village of Vernon Hills Code of Ordinances are as follows:

A. Appendix B - DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS

Article I - Development Ordinances  
Appendix II - Engineering Specifications

Section F. 14.p. - SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM

That Section F.14.p. of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Vernon Hills, Illinois, is hereby added to read as follows:

*p.* Grease Traps shall conform to Lake County Department of Public Works Engineering standards, and be approved by them.

For structures within pavement areas, the pavement material shall be eight (8) inch IDOT Class SI concrete. The pavement shall be reinforced with 6 x 6 W2.9 x W2.9 WWF.

For Grease Trap installations outside of pavement, a minimum of twelve (12) inches of topsoil shall be placed to allow for final stabilization. Trees shall not be placed over the top of Grease Traps.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

THAT, the Village Board of Vernon Hills approves said amendments to the Village's Code of Ordinances.


