

**AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DEFRANCO PLUMBING TO REPLACE  
GALVANIZED WATER LINES WITHIN THE ORIGINAL SECTION OF THE PUBLIC  
WORKS BUILDING FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$41,900**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*"the Village"*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the condition of the galvanized water lines within the original 1978 section of the Public Works building have deteriorated and are producing rusty, non-potable water; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village budgeted \$60,000 within FY2017-18 budget account (0209046-550040) to replace said pipe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village received three (3) proposals with Arrow Plumbing providing the lowest proposal of \$22,897, however, said proposal did not include insulating the newly installed piping; and

**WHEREAS**, DeFranco Plumbing submitted the second lowest proposal in the amount of \$41,900 which did include insulating the newly installed piping; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village's job specifications required to insulate the all piping; therefore, staff is recommending to award the contract to DeFranco Plumbing; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope of work will include: demolition of the existing water piping for hot, cold and return lines, installation of new copper piping for hot, cold, and return lines, reconnection of all fittings, and insulating new piping; and

**WHEREAS**, consolidated purchases throughout the budget year of over \$20,000 require Board of Trustees approval.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with DeFranco Plumbing to replace the existing galvanized water lines within the Public Works building per the above mentioned scope of work not to exceed \$41,900.

**SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT:** The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment to DeFranco Plumbing in an amount not to exceed \$41,900 for said services.

**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

**SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2018-067.




