

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-102

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS CODE OF ORDINANCES
CHAPTER 3, SECTIONS 3-12, LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATION AND SECTION 25,
SECTION 25-3, FEES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills is a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the Village, as a municipal corporation, has a duty to regulate the purchase, sale and serving of alcoholic beverages to the public for the protection of the public, health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt this ordinance amending the Liquor Control Ordinance of the Village of Vernon Hills pursuant to its duty to regulate the purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages within the Village of Vernon Hills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Chapter 3 Section 3-12 of the Village of Vernon Hills Liquor Code is hereby amended by addition of new section, 3-12(15) creating Liquor License Classification "O" to read as follows:

3-12(15) Class "O" License: A class "O" license shall authorize the service of beer only for consumption on premise as an incidental part of a barbershop. Class "O" licenses shall be subject to the following conditions and limitations.

1. The service of beer on the premises shall be permitted only in connection with a barbershop. For the purpose of these requirements, a "Barbershop" is a business establishment, having a minimum gross floor area of 1,500 square feet that offers personal hair cutting and styling services including the trimming of beards and neck or facial shaving.
2. The service of beer for consumption on premise shall be limited to one individual serving as part of hair, beard or shaving services and shall be served in accordance with Section 3-37 of the Liquor and License Code.
3. It is intended that the service of beer is merely an adjunct to the operation of a barbershop and that the facility shall not be advertised or otherwise held out to be a drinking establishment.
4. Hours for the service of beer shall be in accordance with Section 3-23 of the Liquor Code. It shall be prohibited to serve or consume beer outside of normal business hours.
5. Not more than one (1) class "O" license shall be issued at any one time in the Village.

SECTION II. That Chapter 25 Section 25-3 of the Village of Vernon Hills Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by addition of the following fees for a Class "O" Liquor License to read as follows:

25-3. Fee required: Class "O" Liquor License fees shall be \$300.00 for new license applications and \$1,000.00 for the annual license fee.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VI. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet for in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VI. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2018-102.


