



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-115 AUTHORIZING APPROVAL
OF A \$50,000 INCREASE IN PAYMENT FOR CERTAIN LEGAL SERVICES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 - 2019**

WHEREAS, all professional service engagements that require the expenditure of over \$25,000, require Board of Trustees approval; and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 2018-073, the Village Board authorized payment to Hunt & Associates for legal services not to exceed \$50,000 and Ordinance 2018-073 authorized an increase of \$100,000 bringing the purchase order total to \$150,000 and

WHEREAS, due to the need for additional legal services, an increase of \$50,000 is required bringing the purchase order total to \$200,000 for Hunt & Associates. These funds are in the FY2018-2019 budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, the Village Manager is authorized to execute payments to Hunt & Associates in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.


