

ORDINANCE 2018-134
AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS
AND PROVIDING FOR DISPOSAL

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of such surplus property by donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely.

1. One (1) Coats model 1001 Electronic Wheel Balancer, serial #068601-5997

SECTION II. The said surplus property is to be donated to the Vernon Hills Park District, Park Maintenance Department, 1400 Indianwood Drive, Vernon Hills, IL 60061

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several application, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VI. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2018-134.


