

ORDINANCE 2018-148

**AN OMNIBUS ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY
RECOVERED AND/OR TAKEN IN BY THE
VERNON HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT DURING 2018 AND 2019**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills is a Municipal Corporation of the State of Illinois and operates a Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Village of Vernon Hills Police Department comes into possession of lost, stolen or mislaid property from time to time including varying types a personal property including cell phones, bicycles, and other assorted items ; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Law Enforcement Disposition Of Property Act, 765 ILCS § 1030 governs the disposition of property and the manner in method in which a police organization may dispose of property it acquires; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills Police Department desires inappropriate and efficient means of disposing of property while providing Full disclosure and transparency;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS UNDER THEIR HOME RULE AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 2: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2018-148

SECTION 3: DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY The Village Board Of Trustees hereby authorizes the Chief of Police, or his or her designee, to dispose of property during the remainder of the calendar year 2018 and throughout calendar year 2019 in the manner prescribed by Vernon Hills ordinance number 2018- 147 And the and the Illinois law enforcement disposition of property act, 765 ILCS § 1030 and to make monthly and annual reports to the Board of Trustees as required there under.




