

ORDINANCE 2018-147

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE METHOD FOR DISPOSING OF PROPERTY RECOVERED AND/OR TAKEN IN BY THE VERNON HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT AND CREATING AN OMNIBUS PROCEDURE FOR AN ANNUAL ORDINANCE AND PERIODIC REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills is a Municipal Corporation of the State of Illinois and operates a Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Village of Vernon Hills Police Department comes into possession of lost, stolen or mislaid property from time to time including varying types a personal property including cell phones, bicycles, and other assorted items ; and

**WHEREAS**, The Illinois Law Enforcement Disposition of Property Act, 765 ILCS § 1030 governs the disposition of property and the manner in method in which a police organization may dispose of property it acquires; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills Police Department desires inappropriate and efficient means of disposing of property while providing Full disclosure and transparency;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS UNDER THEIR HOME RULE AUTHORITY:**

**SECTION 1: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

**SECTION 2: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2018-147

**SECTION 3: DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY** The Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Chief of Police , or his or her designee, to dispose of property from time to time in accordance with the Illinois Law Enforcement Property Disposition Act 765 ILCS § 1030 to the Board of Trustees on an annual basis for consideration an Ordinance providing for the disposition of property for the entire year; provided however that the Police Chief shall submit on a monthly basis with his or her monthly report to the Board of Trustees a detailed listing of all property having been disposed of, and further providing that such report identify the name or entity to whom any property being disposed of was either sold or donated; and further provided that the Police Chief shall on an annual basis provide the Board of Trustees with an accounting of all monies received during the preceding fiscal quarter from the sale of such property.
