ORDINANCE 2020-092**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES TO IMPERIAL SURVEILLANCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT CCTV SYSTEM FOR THE ARBOR THEATER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,300.00

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*“the Village”*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the existing cameras and recording system at the Arbortheater are no longer functional and beyond repair, and

WHEREAS, the Village solicited quotes from previous vendors used by the Village and were familiar with the existing systems, and

WHEREAS, Imperial Surveillance provided the lowest quote, is reducing the number of cameras but improving the recording capabilities, and is utilizing existing recording capacity; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT: The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute all required documents to purchase the replacement CCTV system from Imperial Surveillance at a price not to exceed \$4,300.00.

SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT: The Finance Department is hereby authorized to make payment to Imperial Surveillance in an amount not to exceed \$4,300.00, per the attached quote in Exhibit A, utilizing account 0209005-540050.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2020-092.



A late payment charge of 1 1/2% per month may be added to all amounts that remain unpaid for more than thirty(30)days,which is an Annual Percentage Rate of 19.56%. (Outlined in Terms and Conditions and in Items 14 & 15)

\$ Dollars per month, for **Cloud Recording Services**, payable quarterly in advance. Monthly charges may be prorated to coincide with standard periods. A late payment charge of 1 1/2% per month may be added to all amounts that remain unpaid for more than thirty(30)days,which is an Annual Percentage Rate of 19.56%. (Outlined In Terms and Conditions and in Items 13)

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT IF ANY AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION REQUIRES ANY CHANGES AND/OR PERMIT FEES TO THE ABOVE SYSTEM,IT WILL BE AT ADDITIONAL EXPENSE TO THE SUB. SUB ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED ON THE REVERSE OR BELOW INCLUDING THE LIQUIDATED DAMAGES(PAR.5), INDEMNIFICATION OF SECURITY CO (PAR.6)AND WAIVER OF SUBROGATION (PAR.7)ARE MADE PART OF THIS AGREEMENT AND ARE INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE HEREIN. THIS AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FOR A PERIOD OF 5 Years FROM THE DATE ON WHICH THE MONTHLY CHARGES OR TIME AND MATERIAL CHARGE SUNDER THIS AGREEMENT BECOME EFFECTIVE,AND THERE AFTER SHALL AUTOMATICALLY RENEW FOR SUCCESSIVE TERM SEQUAL TO THE INITIAL TERM. 1. Completely Install (2) AXIS IP Multi Sensor Cameras, (1) POE, (2) SD cards
2. Run New Cat6
3. Mount and Program all cameras with the necessary information to communicate with the recording servers.
4. Install the Video Management Software that will be responsible for the processing of all video data.
5. Adjust all Cameras to provide the best possible picture & coverage of the desired areas.
6. Train all appropriate personnel on the operation of the system. This will be done upon project completion and can include all necessary personnel.
