

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
ORDINANCE 2020-121**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS
AND PROVIDING FOR SALE**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the Village's 2016 Ford E350 8 Passenger Paratransit Bus is no longer needed since a voucher system was implemented; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of said surplus property by sale.

WHEREAS, SRA CLC is located within the Village of VH & the Village Board has determined that it would be in the resident's best interest to sell said bus to them for \$1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely.

1. One (1) 2016 Ford E350 Eight Passenger Paratransit Bus w/ Wheelchair Lift

SECTION II. The said surplus property is to be sold to the Special Recreation Association of Central Lake County (SRA-CLC), located at 290 Oakwood Rd., Vernon Hills, IL 60061 for the amount of \$1.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several application, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VI. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.

SECTION VII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2020-121.


