AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES TO BURRIS EQUIPMENT CO. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2021 KUBOTA RTV-X1100CWL-H UTILITY VEHICLE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,869.60

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*"the Village"*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, funds are delineated in FY2022 budget account (2102040-540030) for vehicle purchases; and

WHEREAS, Burris Equipment Co., 2216 N. Greenbay Rd., Waukegan, IL 60087 is an authorized Kubota dealership that has been selected through a competitive bidding process to provide utility vehicles to municipalities participating in the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract #062117 at the rate specified in the bid (contract); and

WHEREAS, all purchases over \$25,000 require Board of Trustee approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT: The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Burris Equipment Co. to commit the Village to purchase one (1) 2021 Kubota RTV-X1100CWL-H Utility Vehicle in the amount of \$28,869.60; and

SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION AND RELEASE OF PAYMENT: The Finance Director is authorized to process a purchase order and make payment to Burris Equipment Co., in the amount of \$28,869.60; and

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage, approval and publication as provided by law; and

SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This ordinance shall be known as ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-100.

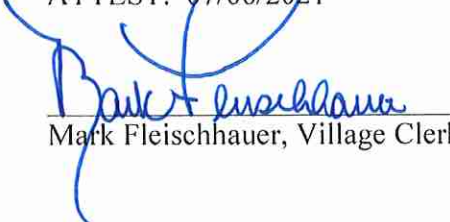
