

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
ORDINANCE 2021-096**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE EQUIPMENT TO BE SURPLUS
AND HAVING LITTLE OR NO VALUE TO DISPOSE OF IN AN APPROPRIATE
MANNER**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of such surplus equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following equipment has little or no value with some item's condition as unknown and declared to be surplus namely;

1. Two (2) LED Radar Feedback Signs

SECTION II. The said surplus equipment is no longer usable as it is broken or is no longer usable for the Village of Vernon Hills.

SECTION III. The said surplus equipment is to be disposed of in an appropriate manner with a combined value of less than \$500.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several application, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VII. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.

SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2021-096.


