The Village's 2022 Road Rehabilitation Project Improvements will be performed on the following streets:

- **Gregg's Parkway between Butterfield Road and just east of Sycamore Drive**
- **St. Andrew Drive/Stanwich Drive**
- **Shoal Creek Terrace**
- **Locke Lane**
- **Torrey Pines Way**
- **Cog Hill Court**
- **Butler Court**
- **Baltimore Drive**
- **Congressional Court**
- **Sycamore Street**
- **Maidstone Drive**
- **Crooked Stick Court**
- **Ridgewood Court**
- **Quaker Ridge Court**

PHASE 1 SCOPE OF WORK

Concrete rehabilitation work will include curb/gutter removal and replacement, sidewalk removal and replacement, and drainage structure improvements.

During this phase of construction homeowners are asked not to park on the streets between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm to allow the contractor to perform work.

Homeowners whose driveway access may be interrupted by concrete removal and replacement, will be allowed to park overnight on the street. Arrangements will be made with the Police Department to allow overnight street parking during **Phase 1** construction only.

Please do not park in front of fire hydrants, at corners or blocking sidewalks and driveways, violators will be ticketed.

PHASE 2 SCOPE OF WORK

Once the concrete removal and replacement work has been substantially completed, Asphalt pavement surface milling, asphalt patching, asphalt pavement cleaning and preparation, asphalt pavement prime (oil), asphalt pavement overlay will occur.

Vehicles will not be permitted to be parked on any street during this construction phase. Please have vehicles relocated off the streets between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:30 pm. Overnight street parking is not allowed.

- This project is tentatively scheduled to begin May 2, 2022 and be substantially completed by early July 2022.

Restoration of the disturbed areas will include the backfilling of open holes during Phase 1 until final restoration can be completed in September.

Delays during construction can be expected, please observe construction signs and direction of any workers or flag persons present.

Homeowners with invisible pet fences and irrigation systems are asked to contact us as soon as possible so that we can avoid damage. Residents with other concerns should also contact us so that arrangements can be made.

Mail delivery and trash pickup will continue as scheduled. Trash cans shall not be placed in the street but at the end of the drive apron. Some delays may occur, and pickup times may be adjusted to accommodate the construction.
