

## **2022 Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of May 16<sup>th</sup>:**

Phase 1 of the Road Project will continue with the removal and replacement of concrete curb/gutter and sidewalks in the St. Andrews subdivision. The contractor will complete the concrete replacement in the Muirfield subdivision.

Removal and Replacement of curb/gutter and sidewalks are weather permitting. **Delays can be expected.**

For those residents whose curb and/or sidewalk that have been identified for concrete removal and replacement at their driveways you will need to relocate your vehicles to the street by 7:00 am the day after a notice has been placed at your front door. Once the concrete has been replaced and 3 to 5 days after the barricades have been removed by the contractor, you will be able to use your driveway again.

Residents who will be unable to access their driveways during the first phase of construction will be allowed to park on the street overnight. Residents and guest are asked to not park in the locations where barricades have been placed, not blocking driveways, near fire hydrants and at crosswalks/corners where prohibited by law. If possible, please park your vehicle on the opposite side of the street that is being worked on to allow buses, garbage trucks and delivery vans to be able to pass.

We have notified the Police Department not to issue tickets to the residents where work is being performed by our contractor for overnight parking during this Phase 1 of construction only.

School Bus pickup and drop-off, Postal service, and trash pick-up will continue as scheduled.
