

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS  
ORDINANCE 2022-069**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-112 AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN EXPENDITURES TO A LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE ILLINOIS ROUTE 21 MALL TO MALL ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS FROM A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$309,910 TO AN AMOUNT OF \$325,810**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*“the Village”*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2021-112 awarded a contract to A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. to facilitate cross access between the Melody Farm and Hawthorn Mall with pedestrian enhancements, and traffic signal improvements for an amount not to exceed \$309,910; and

**WHEREAS**, a Change Order to the initial scope of work was approved after-the-fact to include the resurfacing of the IDOT apron in the Right-of-Way from Milwaukee Ave. at the intersection of the former Denny’s; in addition to performing curb work after the traffic signal turn-on; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost for the additional work totaled \$15,900; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff seeks approval to increase expenditures to A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. for said additional work from \$309,910 to \$325,810; and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funds are available within the Melody Farm TIF to bridge the \$15,900 difference; and

**WHEREAS**, expenditures over \$25,000 require Village Board approval.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT:** The Finance Director is hereby authorized to increase FY2022 Purchase Order #1223 from \$309,910 to \$325,810, and to make payments to A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$325,810.

**SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

**SECTION 3: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-069.




