

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
ORDINANCE 2022-065**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2022-024 AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN EXPENDITURES TO PETROLEUM TRADERS CORP. TO FURNISH & DELIVER FUEL FROM A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$252,000.00 TO A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$253,488.52

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*“the Village”*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village purchases fuel for use in its fleet from a fuel supplier; and

WHEREAS, Community School District #128, Hawthorn School District #73, Cook Memorial Library, Countryside Fire Protection District, Vernon Hills Park District and the MEG Unit utilize the Village's supply of fuel; and each user reimburses the Village the amount the Village pays plus an \$.08 surcharge per gallon of usage each month; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-024 amended Ordinance 2022-035 authorizing an increase in expenditures to Petroleum Traders Corp. for the purchase of fuel from \$222,000 to \$252,000 due to the high fuel prices; and

WHEREAS, the price of fuel has remained at a higher than anticipated cost through the month of April; therefore, an additional \$1,488.52 is needed to cover the cost of fuel purchased during the month; and

WHEREAS, \$1,488.52 is available within the current Public Works FY2022 budget for said purchase.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT: The Finance Director is hereby authorized to increase FY2022 Purchase Order #032 to Petroleum Traders Corp. from \$252,000.00 to \$253,488.52, and to make payments to Petroleum Traders Corp. in an amount not to exceed \$253,488.52 within Fiscal Year 2022.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 3: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-065.


