

2022 Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of June 18th:

The contractor will begin placing the final surface of asphalt paving beginning in the St. Andrew subdivision on Friday June 17th. The pavement will be swept clean and a light coat of the asphalt prime will be sprayed.

On Saturday June 18th the contractor will be placing the final surface of asphalt on Gregg's Parkway. The Village has granted permission for our contractor to begin paving operations at 5:30 am on Gregg's Parkway only. Due to the limited access for the contractor to perform this work, this will help reduce the amount of delays and potential traffic impacts at the Gregg's Parkway and Butterfield Road intersection. Delays can be expected when the paving operations commence on Gregg's Parkway.

The final surface will continue on during the week of June 20th until complete.

****Residents are asked to relocate vehicles off the streets currently under construction during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm (Village working hours).***

Motorist should avoid making any sharp turns or movements on the new surface until it cools down.

****A special note for homeowners, when the prime coat/oil is placed please be cautious of crossing the streets, especially with pets. This also applies when the asphalt surfaces are placed, as the asphalt is very hot and if the air temperatures are high, it takes longer for the pavement to cool down.***

Overnight parking on Village streets is not allowed and please place all garbage cans out of the roadway and at the ends of your driveways not in the street.
