



**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ILLINOIS COUNTIES  
RISK MANAGEMENT TRUST TO PROVIDE WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE  
COVERAGE FOR DECEMBER 1, 2022 – DECEMBER 1, 2023 FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO  
EXCEED \$473,763**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois ("*the Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village must maintain worker's compensation insurance coverage ("*insurance coverage*"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has determined that Alliant/Mesirow Insurance Services ("*Alliant/Mesirow*") is well suited to act as the Village's Broker on behalf of the Village of Vernon Hills' worker's compensation insurance plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Alliant/Mesirow has solicited quotes from the market for insurance coverage and recommends that the Village obtain insurance coverage from the Illinois Counties Risk Management Trust ("*ICRMT*"); and

**WHEREAS**, premiums for this insurance coverage are \$473,763, payable in semi-annual installments, without deductibles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of the Village of Vernon Hills ("*Village Board*") has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to bind coverage with ICRMT for the December, 1 2022 through December 1, 2023 coverage period.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION TO SECURE COVERAGE:** The Village Manager shall be, and is hereby, authorized to execute any and all documents required to secure insurance coverage with ICRMT, as approved by the Village's Corporation Counsel.

**SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT:** The Village Manager is authorized to commit the Village to make payments to Illinois Counties Risk Management Trust not to exceed \$473,763, and authorize the Finance Director to release these payments prior to appearing on the Board Invoice Approval List.

**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

**SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-124.




