

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
ORDINANCE 2023-061**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS
AND PROVIDING FOR THE SALE BY PUBLIC OR INTERNET AUCTION**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to donate and/or sell such surplus property by public or internet auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely.

1. 2004 Ford F-350 4X4 1-Ton Dump Truck VIN: 1FDWF37P44EB58651
2. 2004 Ford F-350 4X4 1-Ton Dump Truck VIN: 1FDWF37P24EB58650
3. 2008 Ford Edge AWD SUV VIN: 2FMDK48C18BA64958
4. 2022 Ford F-250 Standard 8 foot truck bed

SECTION II. The said surplus property is to be sold through a public or internet auction with the exception of one 1-Ton Dump Truck which will be donated to the Boy Scouts of America – Northeast Illinois Council located in Vernon Hills.

SECTION III. The said surplus property shall individually be withdrawn from the sale at the public or internet auction unless the following minimum sum shall be bid for said property:

1. 2004 Ford F-350 4X4 1-Ton Dump Truck VIN: 1FDWF37P44EB58651 as described in Section I (1) above, Not Applicable – to be donated.
2. 2004 Ford F-350 4X4 1-Ton Dump Truck VIN: 1FDWF37P24EB58650 as described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$15,000.00
3. 2008 Ford Edge AWD SUV VIN: 2FMDK48C18BA64958 as described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$1,500.00
4. 2022 Ford F-250 Standard 8 foot truck bed as described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$1,000.00

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several application, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VII. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2023-061

I am writing on behalf of the Northeast Illinois Council, which serves over 3,300 youth in the northeast Illinois area. We currently have three camp properties that provide great, close camping opportunities for Scouts and other youth organizations. These properties require a great deal of maintenance, and some of the most useful pieces of equipment for helping to maintain them are flatbed trucks or dump trucks. These types of vehicles are essential for moving around the volume of brush, earth, gravel, firewood, and program supplies that we use to support our youth programs at our camps. In 2022, we had almost 8,300 nights of camping at our camps, not including our summer camp operations. We had 1,620 Scouts attend Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan last summer over 6 weeks.

In the late 90s', we were fortunate to receive a pair of such trucks that were donated by the Village of Vernon Hills. They were essential in keeping our Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan Scout Reservation in good repair and supporting our mission at developing tomorrow's leaders through outdoor youth programming. These trucks were in service at Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan for another twelve to fifteen years after the Village donated them.

If Vernon Hills is considering upgrading its vehicle fleet in the next year, I ask that the Village considers donating a truck to our camping programs. Additionally, if there are other pieces of landscaping equipment or tools that you will be replacing, those would also be put to great use ensuring Scouts have appealing and safe camping areas. Any donated vehicle or equipment would be deeply appreciated and put to good use supporting our Scouts' development for years to come.


