

RESOLUTION 2011-035

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE LAKE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE USE OF THEIR OUTDOOR FIRING RANGE.

WHEREAS, Vernon Hills police officers are mandated by state statute to receive firearms training, at least annually; and

WHEREAS, the Vernon Hills Police Department does not have a firing range capable of handling high-powered rifles; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office maintains a firing range for the use of Lake County police officers; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills and the Lake County Sheriff are authorized by state statute to enter into intergovernmental agreements, ventures, and undertakings, to perform jointly and governmental purpose, or undertaking;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

That the Village Manager is authorized to sign an intergovernmental agreement with the Lake County Sheriff for the purpose of using their firearms training facility for the purpose of training and qualifying its police officers and maintaining firearms proficiency.


